- completion of Years 1, 2 and 3 of the Bachelor of Urban and Environmental Planning (1086 or 1279)
- an overall achievement of a GPA of at least 5.5 for the courses listed in Years 2 and 3 of the Bachelor of Urban and Environmental Planning (1086 or 1279)
- completion of **4029ENV Project Proposal for Honours**
- the suitability of the proposed dissertation topic
- the resources available to support the candidature including availability of appropriate supervision.

Note: Entry is competitive and will be determined by order of academic merit and is subject to available supervisory resources.

Students who do not achieve the standard necessary to transfer to the Bachelor of Urban and Environmental Planning (Honours) (1431 or 1432) will be required to remain in the Bachelor of Urban and Environmental Planning (1086 or 1279) and complete the following courses.
