- 10 credit points of Arts foundation courses for your chosen major; AND

- 60 credit points for one Arts major; AND
- 60 credit points for one Business major, AND
- 60 credit points for free-choice electives.

For students who wish to complete an extended major

- 60 credit points for one Arts major; AND
- 80 credit points for an extended Business major and 40 credit points for free-choice electives; **or**
- 90 credit points for the Accounting (extended) major and 30 credit points for free-choice electives.

For International students required to complete the English Language Enhancement course

For the award of *Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Business (BA/BBus)*, you must successfully complete 320 credit points, made up of the core courses AND

- 10 credit points for the English Language Enhancement course (5904LHS); AND
- 10 credit points of Arts foundation courses for your chosen major; AND
- 20 credit points of Arts first year electives AND

For students who wish to complete a major

- 60 credit points for one Arts major; AND
- 60 credit points for one Business major, AND
- 60 credit points for free-choice electives.

For students who wish to complete an extended major

- 60 credit points for one Arts major; AND
- 80 credit points for an extended Business major and 40 credit points for free-choice electives; **or**
- 90 credit points for the Accounting (extended) major and 30 credit points for free-choice electives.

Other program requirements

You must successfully complete:

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.
