Standard pathway

For Domestic and those International students not required to complete the English Language Enhancement course

For the award of the *Bachelor of Aviation Management (BAvnMgt)*, you must successfully complete 240 credit points, made up of the core courses AND

- 20 credit points of listed electives;
- 30 credit points of free-choice electives.

Other program requirements

You must successfully complete:

- no more than 100 credit points of Level 1 courses (the first digit of a course code denotes the level);
- at least 60 credit points of Level 3 courses or higher.

Professional Entry pathway

For Domestic and those International students not required to complete the English Language Enhancement course

For the award of the *Bachelor of Aviation Management (BAvnMgt)*, students entering with 120 credit points of advanced standing must successfully complete 120 credit points, made up of the core courses AND

- 20 credit points of free-choice electives;
- a maximum of 10 credit points of Level 1 courses.

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.
