Degree requirements: Students who started Trimester 2 - 2020

For Domestic and those International students not required to complete the English Language Enhancement course

For the award of *Bachelor of Criminology and Criminal Justice (BCCJ)*, you must successfully complete 240 credit points, made up of the core courses AND

- 40 credit points of listed Criminology and Criminal Justice electives;
- 50 credit points of free-choice electives.

For those international students required to complete the English Language Enhancement course

For the award of *Bachelor of Criminology and Criminal Justice (BCCJ)*, you must successfully complete 240 credit points, made up of the core courses AND

- 10 credit points for the English Language Enhancement course (5904LHS);
- 40 credit points of listed Criminology and Criminal Justice electives;
- 40 credit points of free-choice electives.

Other program requirements

You must successfully complete:

- no more than 100 credit points of Level 1 courses (the first digit of a course code denotes the level);
- at least 60 credit points of Level 3 courses or higher.

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.

English Language Enhancement

Students must have participated in a formal application process during their 3007CCJ course for entry into 3008CCJ.

Note 2: This course is available to students who want to complete a professional placement but were not successful in the competitive round for gaining a placement in 3008CCJ. It provides an opportunity to gain workplace experience in a criminal justice setting.
