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### Degree requirements: Students who started Trimester 2 - 2024

For the award of *Bachelor of Social Work (Honours) [BSocWk(Hons)]*, you must successfully complete 320 credit points, made up of the core courses AND

- 30 credit points for the dissertation courses;
- 10 credit points of listed electives;
- 10 credit points of free-choice electives.

### Other program requirements

You must successfully complete:

- no more than 100 credit points of Level 1 courses (the first digit of a course code denotes the level);
- at least 60 credit points of Level 3 courses or higher.
