### Degree requirements: Students who started Trimester 3 - 2024

#### For Domestic and those International students not required to complete the English Language Enhancement course

For the award of *Bachelor of Exercise Science/Bachelor of Business (BExSc/BBus)*, you must successfully complete 370 credit points, made up of the core courses AND

- 60 credit points for the Sport Management major: AND
- 30 credit points of free-choice electives at Level 2 or higher.

#### For International students required to complete the English Language Enhancement course

For the award of *Bachelor of Exercise Science/Bachelor of Business (BExSc/BBus)*, you must successfully complete 370 credit points, made up of the core courses AND

- 10 credit points for the English Language Enhancement course (5902LHS);
- 60 credit points for the Sport Management major: AND
- 20 credit points of free-choice electives at Level 2 or higher.

#### Other program requirements

You must successfully complete:

- no more than 140 credit points of Level 1 courses (the first number of a course code denotes the level);
- at least 60 credit points of Level 3 courses or higher.

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.
