This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.

Alternatively, if you would like to undertake **Honours**, you are advised to apply for an internal transfer to the **Bachelor of Laws (Honours) (1526)** at Nathan or **Bachelor of Laws (Honours) (1527)** at the Gold Coast prior to graduating from this program.
