For the award of *Bachelor of Laws/Bachelor of Commerce (LLB/BCom)*, you must successfully complete 440 credit points, made up of the core courses AND

- 60 credit points for a Commerce major;
- 70 credit points of Listed Law electives;
- 30 credit points of Listed Commerce electives;
- 30 credit points of free-choice electives.

Other program requirements

You must successfully complete:

- no more than 120 credit points of Level 1 courses (the first digit of a course code denotes the level);
- at least 60 credit points of Level 3 courses or higher.

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.
