Degree requirements: Students who started Trimester 1 - 2022

For the award of *Bachelor of Laws (Honours)/Bachelor of Arts [LLB (Hons)/BA]*, you must successfully complete 440 credit points, made up of the core courses AND

- 10 credit points of Arts foundation courses;
- 20 credit points of Arts First Year Electives
- 100 credit points of listed Law electives;
- one 60 credit point Arts major **AND**
- 30 credit points of free-choice electives

Note: You may only undertake a language major in which you are not a native speaker and you cannot complete two language majors.

Other program requirements

You must successfully complete:

- no more than 120 credit points of Level 1 courses (the first digit of a course code denotes the level);
- at least 60 credit points of Level 3 courses or higher.

Students achieving a GPA of less than 4.000 will be awarded an AQF Level 7 Bachelor of Laws.
