Spanish Language

Students may only undertake a language minor in which they are not native speakers. Language courses must be taken in

sequence in accordance with the prerequisites specified. Students may commence at either first or second year depending on their level of proficiency.

Those who have completed Year 11 and 12 language study at secondary school or have some other level of proficiency should contact the School of Humanities, Languages and Social Science at Griffith to discuss the level at which to enrol.

Students commencing with an advanced level of proficiency are encouraged to take the 'Enhanced' 20 credit point course option where available.
