For the award of *Bachelor of Urban Planning (Honours) [BUrbanPlan(Hons)]*, you must successfully complete 320 credit points, made up of the core courses AND

- 60 credit points for a Major (including 30 credit points for dissertation on a topic from your major area); OR
 - if you elect not to complete a major, you will complete 30 credit points for dissertation and 30 credit points of listed electives.
- 10 credit points of listed Architecture electives;
- 10 credit points of free-choice electives.

For Domestic and those International students required to complete the English Language Enhancement course

For the award of *Bachelor of Urban Planning (Honours) [BUrbanPlan(Hons)]*, you must successfully complete 320 credit points, made up of the core courses AND

- 10 credit points for the English Language Enhancement course (5903LHS); AND
- 60 credit points for a Major (including 30 credit points for dissertation on a topic from your major area); OR
 - if you elect not to complete a major, you will complete 30 credit points for dissertation and 30 credit points of listed electives.
- 10 credit points of listed Architecture electives.

Other program requirements

- no more than 100 credit points of Level 1 courses (the first digit of a course code denotes the level);
- at least 60 credit points of Level 3 courses or higher.
