### Degree requirements: Students who started Trimester 1 - 2025

#### For Domestic and those International students not required to complete the English Language Enhancement course

For the award of *Bachelor of Urban Studies [BUrbanSt]*, you must successfully complete 240 credit points as prescribed below:

- at least 210 credit points from the Bachelor of Urban Studies course lists for any major including all level 1 and 2 core courses;
- no more than 30 credit points of Undergraduate free-choice elective/s .

#### For Domestic and those International students required to complete the English Language Enhancement course

For the award of *Bachelor of Urban Studies [BUrbanSt]*, you must successfully complete 240 credit points as prescribed below:

- at least 210 credit points from the Bachelor of Urban Studies course lists for any major including all level 1 and 2 core courses;
- 10 credit points for the English Language Enhancement course (5903LHS);
- no more than 20 credit points of Undergraduate free-choice elective/s .

#### Other program requirements

You must successfully complete:

- no more than 100 credit points of Level 1 courses (the first digit of a course code denotes the level);
- at least 60 credit points of Level 3 courses or higher.

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.

#### Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) Level and Type

The **Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF)** is the national policy for regulated qualifications in Australian education and training. This qualification is accredited as an AQF Level 7 - Bachelor Degree.

#### English Language Enhancement

All undergraduate International students are required to complete an **English Language Enhancement Course** unless specific criteria are met as specified in Section 5.0 **Qualifications Procedure**.

The following course must be completed in the first trimester of study:

- **5903LHS Language and Communication for Sciences**

Advice regarding the requirement to complete the English Language Enhancement Course is available via the *myGriffith* portal (in the To Do List).

**Students whose first language is English are not permitted to undertake this course.**
