To be eligible for the award of *Bachelor of Arts (Honours) [BA(Hons)]*, a student must acquire 80 credit points as prescribed below:

- gain 20 credit points for prescribed coursework;
- gain 10 credit points for a listed elective;
- successfully complete the 50 credit point dissertation/project.

- gain 10 credit points for 6004ESC Advanced Methods in Archaeological Science
- successfully complete the 50 credit point dissertation/project
