## Degree requirements: Students who started Trimester 1 - 2023

To be eligible for the *Bachelor of Human Services (Honours) [BHuServ(Hons)]*, a student must acquire 80 credit points as prescribed below:

- gain 30 credit points for the prescribed courses
- gain 20 credit points for listed electives
- successfully complete the 30 credit point dissertation.

**Note:** The minimum period required to complete the degree is one year and the maximum time for completing the degree is three years inclusive of periods of leave of absence, termination or exclusion.
