# What are the fees?

#### Fee-paying postgraduate (domestic) students

## Indicative annual tuition fee

The indicative annual tuition fee is calculated based on a standard full-time study load which is usually 80 credit points.

#### Tuition fees

- A fee-paying postgraduate student pays tuition fees.

- The tuition fee for students who commence their program from 2014 onwards is charged according to the approved program fee for the trimester in which the student is enrolled.
