### Degree requirements: Students who started Trimester 2 - 2024

To be eligible for the award of *Graduate Diploma of Health Research (GDipHealthRes)*, a student must acquire 80 credit points as prescribed below:

- gain 20 credit points for the core courses
- gain 20 credit points from the listed elective courses
- gain 40 credit points for the research dissertation.

### Exit point

To be eligible to exit the Graduate Diploma of Health Research program with the Graduate Certificate in Health Research award, a student must acquire 40 credit points as prescribed below:

- gain 40 credit points for the prescribed coursework
- OR gain 40 credit points for the Dissertation courses (where evidence is provided that the student has successfully completed at least 40 credit points of postgraduate coursework comprising a minimum of 20 credit points of research courses including a research preparation course such as [6001HLS Dissertation Preparation](#), [7001HSV Foundations of Research Inquiry](#) or equivalent and subject to prior Program Director approval).

To exit, a student should apply for a program transfer.
