### Degree requirements: Students who started Trimester 3 - 2024

To be eligible for the award of *Graduate Diploma of Flight Management (GDipFIMgt)*, a student must:

- gain 60 credit points for the core courses and
- gain 30 credit points for either the Flight Instructor Rating (FIR) pathway or Instrument Rating (IR) pathway.

### Exit point

To be eligible to exit the Graduate Diploma program with the Graduate Certificate in Flight Management award, a student must acquire 60 credit points as specified in the course list. To exit, a student should apply for a program transfer.
