To be eligible for the award of *Master of Rehabilitation Counselling (MRehabCounsel)*, a student must acquire 120 credit points as prescribed below:

- gain 80 credit points for core courses, including 10 credit points for the field placement
- gain 40 credit points for listed electives
- OR gain 40 credit points for the dissertation component.

To be eligible for the award of *Master of Rehabilitation Counselling (MRehabCounsel)*, a student admitted with **40 credit points of advanced standing** must acquire 80 credit points as prescribed below:

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words 'This award was achieved with Distinction' will be recorded on the testamur.
