## Degree requirements: Students who started Teaching Period 6 - 2018

To be eligible for the award of *Master of Finance (MFin)*, a student must acquire 160 credit points as prescribed below:

- gain 160 credit points for the core courses.

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.

### Exit points

To be eligible to exit this Masters program with the Graduate Certificate in Finance award, a student must acquire 40 credit points for Group 1 courses.

To be eligible to exit this Masters program with the Graduate Diploma of Finance award, a student must acquire 40 credit points for Group 1 courses and 40 credit points for Group 2 courses.

To exit, a student should apply for a program transfer.

## Course list: Students starting Teaching Period 6 - 2018

This program is offered online.

Courses in this program will be offered over six teaching periods per year. Each teaching period is delivered across six weeks. Students will complete one course per teaching period. Teaching periods are scheduled as follows:

- **Teaching Period 1:** From mid-January to late February
- **Teaching Period 2:** From March to late April
- **Teaching Period 3:** From May to mid-June
- **Teaching Period 4:** From July to mid-August
- **Teaching Period 5:** From late August to October
- **Teaching Period 6:** From late October to December

Students must complete the following courses which are offered in three groups. Group 1 courses are to be completed before undertaking Group 2 courses. Group 2 courses are to be completed before undertaking Group 3 courses.

Students unable to undertake courses before their withdrawal are advised to apply for a program transfer to the **Master of Finance (5592)** where courses remain available in both 6 and/or 12 week offerings.
