To be eligible for the award of *Master of Music Research (MMusRes)*, a student must acquire 120 credit points as specified below:

- gain 40 credit points for the prescribed courses and
- gain 80 credit points for the Music Production and Presentation dissertation courses.

Progress review requirements

- completion of the Confirmation of Candidature Milestone within 6 months (equivalent full-time) of commencement
