### Degree requirements: Students who started Trimester 2 - 2024

To be eligible for the award of *Master of Pharmacy (MPharm)*, a student must acquire 240 credit points as prescribed below:

- gain 140 credit points for core courses;
- gain 50 credit points for placement courses;
- gain 10 credit points for dissertation preparation course;
- gain 40 credit points for dissertation courses.

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.
