Degree requirements: Students who started Teaching Period 4 - 2024

To be eligible for the award of *Master of Business Administration (MBA)*, a student must acquire 120 credit points as prescribed below:

- gain 120 credit points for prescribed courses.

To be eligible for the award of *Master of Business Administration (MBA)*, a student admitted with **40 credit points of specified credit** must acquire 80 credit points as prescribed below:

- gain 80 credit points for prescribed courses.

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.
