### Degree requirements: Students who started Trimester 2 - 2024

To be eligible for the award of *Master of Design (MDes)*, a student must acquire 160 credit points as prescribed below:

- gain 120 credit points for the prescribed core courses and
- gain 40 credit points for the Masters Design Project courses.

To be eligible for the award of *Master of Design (MDes)*, a student admitted with **40 credit points of advanced standing** must acquire 120 credit points as prescribed below:

- gain 80 credit points for the prescribed core courses and
- gain 40 credit points for the Masters Design Project courses.

To be eligible for the award of *Master of Design (MDes)*, a student admitted with **80 credit points of advanced standing** must acquire 80 credit points as prescribed below:

- gain 40 credit points for the prescribed core courses and
- gain 40 credit points for the Masters Design Project courses.

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.

To be eligible to exit with the *Graduate Certificate in Design (GCertDes)*, a student must acquire 40 credit points of courses.  
To be eligible to exit with the *Graduate Diploma of Design (GDipDesign)*, a student must acquire 80 credit points of courses.

To exit, a student should apply for a program transfer.
