Degree requirements: Students who started Trimester 1 - 2025

Pathway 1 - 1 year program (80CP)

For the award of *Master of Global Development (MGlobalDev)*, if eligible to complete this program in 1 year, you must successfully complete 80 credit points made up of:

• 80 credit points for the Core Module

Pathway 2 - 1.5 year program (120CP)

For the award of *Master of Global Development (MGlobalDev)*, if eligible to complete this program in 1.5 years, you must successfully complete 120 credit points made up of:

- 80 credit points for the Core Module
- 40 credit points for the Flexible Module

Pathway 3 - 2 year program (160CP)

For the award of *Master of Global Development (MGlobalDev)*, if eligible to complete this program in 2 years, you must successfully complete 160 credit points made up of:

- 40 credit points for the Foundation Module
- 80 credit points for the Core Module
- 40 credit points for the Flexible Module

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.

Exit point

To be eligible to exit the Master of Global Development program with the Graduate Certificate in Global Development award, a student must acquire 40 credit points for the Foundation Module.

To exit, a student should apply for a program transfer.

Dissertation courses

- the suitability of the proposed dissertation topic (approved by the Program Director) and the resources available to support the research including availability of appropriate supervision;
- lodged a completed Nomination of Dissertation Topic and Supervisor form.
