Degree requirements: Students who started Trimester 1 - 2025

Pathway 1 - 1 year program (80 credit points)

For the award of *Master of International Law (MIntLaw)*, if eligible to complete this program in 1 year, you must successfully complete 80 credit points made up of:

- 80 credit points for the Core Module

Pathway 2 - 1.5 year program (120 credit points)

For the award of *Master of International Law (MIntLaw)*, if eligible to complete this program in 1.5 years, you must successfully complete 120 credit points made up of:

- 40 credit points for the Foundation Module AND
- 80 credit points for the Core Module

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.

Exit point

Pathway 2 students must successfully complete 40 credit points of foundation module courses to exit with Graduate Certificate in International Law (3354).

To exit, a student should apply for a program transfer.
