Degree requirements: Students who started Trimester 2 - 2024

For the award of *Master of Education (MEd)*, if eligible to complete this program in **1 year**, you must acquire 80 credit points as prescribed below:

- 80 credit points for the Core Module

For the award of *Master of Education (MEd)*, if eligible to complete this program in **1.5 years**, you must acquire 120 credit points as prescribed below:

- 40 credit points for the Foundation Module
- 80 credit points for the Core Module

For the award of *Master of Education (MEd)*, if eligible to complete this program in **2 years**, you must acquire 160 credit points as prescribed below:

- 40 credit points for the Foundation Module
- 80 credit points for the Core Module
- 40 credit points for the Flexible Module

This degree may be awarded **with Distinction** where a student achieves a minimum program GPA of 6.5 with no failed courses. The words "This award was achieved with Distinction" will be recorded on the testamur.

Exit points
