### How to apply

#### Can I apply?

##### Admission requirements

To be eligible for admission to the **Master of Learning and Professional Development (Singapore)**, applicants must:

- hold a Bachelor degree of at least three years duration in a related discipline with a minimum GPA of 4.5 (using a 7.0 scale);
- have a minimum of three years work experience;
- provide an evidence-informed portfolio demonstrating successful participation in professional development activities and workplace learning.

##### Language requirements

English language requirements apply to International applicants and other applicants whose previous study was undertaken in a language other than English. The minimum English language requirements for such applicants for entry to these programs are described [below](#).

#### What is the application process?

##### How to apply

Applicants are required to download an application form from the [Institute for Adult Learning \(IAL\) Singapore website](#) and submit the completed form together with their portfolio of expertise to IAL.

IAL will collect the student applications and forward them to the School of Education and Professional Studies at Griffith University for assessment by the Program Director. Griffith International will process all applications and send the Letter of Offer and acceptance form together with information on enrolment and Griffith University student policies directly to IAL. This copy, together with the relevant forms from IAL, will be forwarded to the students. Students will return the acceptance form to IAL who will inform Griffith University. Students will then be enrolled by Griffith International.

#### What are the language requirements?

##### Language requirements

English language requirements apply to International applicants and other applicants whose previous study was undertaken in a language other than English. The minimum English language requirements for such applicants for entry to this program are as follows:

- A minimum overall band score of 6.5 on IELTS (Academic) with no sub-score of less than 6.0
- *OR* a minimum score of 575 on TOEFL
- *OR* an internet-based (iBT) TOEFL score of 79 (no sub-score less than 19)
- *OR* no score less than 3+ in each skill of the ISLPR (conducted by ISLPR Language Services only)
- *OR* a minimum overall score of 176 (no score less than 169) on C1 Advanced (formerly Cambridge Certificate in

Advanced English) **or** C2 Proficiency (formerly Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English)

- *OR* an overall score of 58 in the Pearson Test of English (Academic) with no score less than 50.

English test results must be no more than two years old.

The Direct Entry Program (DEP) pathway is not accepted for this program.
